The grade on the Balt. & Ohio Rail
Road will be about 26 feet to the
Mouth of Jennings Run, thence about
80 ft. per mile to the Mouth of Leather Run,
thence about 130 ft. per mile to the Mouth of
Granberry Run.

The line of the Baltimore & Ohio Rail
Road has not been definitely
located. But the route has been
surveyed and the location
will not vary materially from
the route indicated.
